RESOLUTION NO. 05RS003

Resolution regarding brush disposal

WHEREAS, the Department has in the past cut and removed, as necessary, street trees located in the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, there are individuals who contract with property owners to remove trees from private property, which sometimes results in tree limbs being placed on the boulevard and left for removal by the Department; and

WHEREAS, some contractors remove all parts of trees from the private premises, resulting in no brush being placed on the boulevard; and

WHEREAS, it is apparent that property owners requiring removal of brush and trees have available to them private contractors prepared to provide such service; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to encourage all contractors to remove all brush and parts of trees resulting from tree trimming and cutting on private property;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Viroqua, that from and after January 1, 2005, the City discontinue removal of large quantities of brush, including trees and parts of trees, from private property; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event large quantities of brush, including parts of trees, are left on the boulevard, for more than 10 days, the property owner will be given notice by regular mail to remove such brush, including parts of trees, within 10 days of the date of the mailing of such notice and that upon failure to remove such brush, including parts of trees, within such time, the City will remove the same and charge the City's actual cost thereof against the property owner as a special charge for services rendered; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the City will remove small quantities of brush not exceeding four (4) feet in length, tied in small bundles and placed in the boulevard; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City will continue to cut and remove street trees located in the public right-of-way as needed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event of a windstorm or other natural disaster, the City may suspend the provisions of this resolution to assist with the clean up of the community.
