

**CITY OF VIROQUA
COUNCIL MINUTES
MARCH 28, 2017**

1. Roll call:

2. Approval of the March 14, 2017 Regular Council minutes – Motion by Alderperson Polsean/second by Alderperson Bankes to approve the minutes of the March 14, 2017 Council meeting. Voice vote all in favor. Motion carried.
