PLEASE CONTACT DIGGERS HOTLINE TO LOCATE UNDERGROUND UTILITIES BEFORE DIGGING IS STARTED. NO PERMITS WILL BE ISSUED BETWEEN NOVEMBER 15TH AND APRIL 1ST.

Summary of regulations:

- I. Applicant will be responsible for the backfilling of all excavations in the following manner:
 - 1. Tamping of suitable material in twelve (12) inch layers.
 - 2. Minimum of eighteen (18) inches of gravel at top of excavations in traveled portions of streets.
 - 3. Minimum of six (6) inches of sand, gravel, or screenings in areas where sections of sidewalk or curb & gutter are removed.
- II. Applicant must furnish written proof of public liability insurance and maintain such insurance for the duration of the job.
- III. Provide necessary barricading to insure safe travel for the public. If necessary, provide flag man to insure safe travel in street ways.
- IV. The applicant will be responsible for all costs of street, sidewalk, or curb & gutter repair and yard restoration. In the event City crews have to perform any maintenance, expenses will be billed to the applicant.
- V. The applicant is responsible for maintenance of any work done, with regard to the street opening permit, by the applicant/contractor that involves the street right-of-way or sidewalk access for ninety (90) days after completion.

The Common Council of the City of Viroqua ordains as follows:

9.48.010 Whoever makes a false statement or record which he or she knows, or in the exercise of ordinary care should know, is false, when such statement or record is authorized or required by law or is required by any public officer or governmental agency as a prerequisite to such officer or agency taking some official action, shall be required to forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof may be committed to the county jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, not exceeding 30 days.

9.48.020 A permit, license, or other benefit issued, granted, or conferred because of a false statement or record is void.
