- **15. Discussion and approval for 3% water rate increase (Public Works)** Cheryl Purvis explained the need for a simplified rate case. The last time this was completed was 2018. This is an inflationary increase and cheaper than a conventional rate case. Our current rate of return is 3.25% and the target rate is 4.5% per the PSC. After the increase we would be at a 3.7% rate of return. We are currently ranked seventh among other municipalities for rates. The effective date of this would be November 1, 2021 bringing an overall increase in revenue of \$34,358. The basic usage increase would be 23 cents/month with an average increase of 94 cents/month. Motion by Alderperson Birke/second by Alderperson Welter to approve the 3% water rate increase effective November 1, 2021. Roll call vote all in favor. Motion carried.
- **16.** Discussion with possible action on Development Agreement with Fortney Hotel for CDI grant- Council had previously approved a resolution regarding the CDI grant, however WEDC would like a formalized document outlining the process and relationship between the City and Hotel Fortney in regards to the grant. Motion by Alderperson Birke/second by Alderperson Splinter to approve the development agreement with Hotel Fortney. Roll call vote all in favor. Motion carried.
